



## ***Feed the Birds in The Last Green Valley this Winter!***

We have lots of pine cones, and they are in the trees. Hey – so are the birds!

Make some homemade bird feeders, and see how many birds come to have a snack in your yard.



### You will need:

- Pinecones
- Peanut Butter
- Bird Seed
- String

### Directions: This is easy!

Tie a string around your pine cone (you will use this to tie it to a tree branch).

Spread some peanut butter on your pine cone (maybe you could spread some on a celery stick for a snack for yourself, too)!

Roll your pine cone in bird seeds. The sticky peanut butter will make the seeds stick.

Now for the fun! Hang your homemade bird feeder outside and wait for all the birds to arrive! Count how many different birds you see. Learn the names of all the different birds.

It is really a lot of fun, and the birds will say “Thanks Tweetie Pie”!
