

Hand Print Reindeer!

*You've seen hand prints made into turkey.
Now you can make a reindeer, too!*

You'll need:

- ✓ Your hand
- ✓ Piece of white paper (for reindeer handprint) and a piece of colored paper (for backing/frame)
- ✓ Brown poster paint
- ✓ Markers (to add antlers, eyes, nose, hoofs, artist's signature)
- ✓ String (to make a hanging ornament)

To create:

1. Put paint on your hand and fingers, then place your hand on a piece of paper
2. Once the paint dries, cut out around the hand shape.
3. Cut a different colored piece of paper a bit larger than your handprint, and glue or tape together.
4. Draw on antlers, eyes, nose, hoofs, a tail – and be sure to sign your artwork!
5. Tie on the string or ribbon to hang up and display your creation!

You can make this reindeer!
